Day One:

Begin your day with a drive down Historic Route 1, stopping at some of Dinwiddie's locally owned shopping experiences, including Yellow Gate Antiques or Becky Boo-tique.

Take the opportunity to roll down the windows and enjoy the rural landscape while driving down to the town of McKenney. Stop for lunch at **Little Italy** or **Dairy Freeze of McKenney.**



After lunch, head back North on Route 1 to **Appomattox Riverside (Ferndale) Park** to enjoy a portion of the **Appomattox River Trail.** This park features a 1.5 mile portion of the ART, which is a waterfront trail along the Appomattox River. Appomattox Riverside Park also features a playground, swimming, kayaking (with a gravel kayak launch), picnic shelters, and a fishing pier and natural shoreline. After you've explored the river, head to the **Holiday Inn Express & Suites** or **Picture Lake Campground** to unpack and freshen up for a night at **Virginia Motorsports Park.**



For dinner, venture over to **Joe's Steak and Seafood** for a local favorite featuring hearty meat and potatoes dishes. **El Caporal Mexican Restaurant** is also a great option, featuring Mexican cuisines and cocktails.

Finish the night at **Virginia Motorsports Park**, one of the 10 largest motorsports facilities in the world. Featuring a 1/4 drag strip, BMX, autocross and motocross facilities and a mud pit, there is something for every auto lover at Virginia Motorsports Park.
